



## ¿Que Hora Es? - Season 1 Episode Descriptions

*Instructor Dr. Danny Evans teaches introductory Spanish (beginners) to you and along the way, introduces you to aspects of the Hispanic culture.*

### Episode No.

1. Dr. Evans introduces you to Spanish. Dr. Evans teaches the Spanish alphabet, vowels and basic greetings.
2. After review of 1<sup>st</sup> episode, Dr. Evans teaches a new verb “ser”, meaning “to be” in English. Dr. Evans then takes you around the world for a lesson on the various uses of pronouns in Spanish-speaking countries.
3. Dr. Evans reviews pronouns and the verb “ser”. He then discusses the difference between “ser” and “estar” and when to use each of them. Dr. Evans teaches “feeling” words and you will practice, using all of this information, by forming sentences. Dr. Evans explains conversational differences in Spanish-speaking countries and provides a list of topics to avoid when in certain parts of the world.
4. Review of the conversational use of the verbs “ser” and “estar”. You will receive must-have knowledge for traveling in other countries.
5. Dr. Evans teaches a very important verb in the Spanish language “ir”, which means “to go” in English. A cultural lesson about shopping in other countries and money is included in this episode.
6. Dr. Evans reviews different verbs and their different endings. Dr. Evans also discusses festivals and holidays and their importance in Spanish-speaking countries.
7. Dr. Evans provides more reviews of the “er” and “ir” verbs and introduces you to irregular verbs and numbers. The cultural lesson in this episode addresses what to give and what not to give as a thank you when visiting a Spanish-speaking country.
8. Dr. Evans reviews irregular verbs and numbers and teaches you how to tell time in Spanish. The cultural lesson describes the varying concepts of time in different countries.
9. Dr. Evans teaches you the verb “gustar”. You will also learn about food and the variety of dishes commonly eaten in other countries.
10. Family words like “madre” and “padre” (mother and father) are discussed. You will learn the irregular verb “tener” (to have) and the proper way to use numbers. Additional conversational practice is introduced in this episode as well.
11. In this episode you are taught “weather” words and phrases, days of the week, months of the year, and seasons. Geographical differences like altitude and climate are explored.
12. Reflexive verbs describing daily routines and activities are explained.
13. Dr. Evans teaches the words “it” and “them” and also explains auxiliary words (words to fill in gaps) like “mucho” and “muy”.
